CHAPTER ONE JULIUS EWALD KARL His Immediate Family

Julius' mother, Karoline Werner, was born Wednesday, May 19, 1897. His father, who went by Julius or Julian Karl, was born Friday, September 25, 1903. He was thus six years younger than his wife. For purposes of this biography and so as not to confuse the two Juliuses, the elder will be called Julian.

Karoline and Julian were married Sunday, December 18, 1927. Their first child, Erna, was born Tuesday, October 2, 1928. Fourteen months later, their second child, Gertrud, was born Thursday, December 5, 1929. Sixteen months later, their third child, Julius—the subject of this biography—was born Sunday, April 5, 1931. Their fourth and last child, Frieda, arrived twenty-one months later on Saturday, January 14, 1933. It must have been a lively household with four toddlers born within four years and three months.

As you view the photographs included in this biography, please be reminded, according to Julius Ewald, that in those days it was not considered vogue to smile in pictures. Not smiling was considered smarter and probably a bit of a social norm at the time.

The Karls had been married almost sixteen years when dad Julian was conscripted into the German Army. He left the family in 1942, and they never saw him again. Many years later, it

was established that he died in army conflict in Romania in 1944 at age 41. His wife, Karoline, immigrated with her adult children to Canada when she was 56 years old. She lived to the age of 96 and is buried in the cemetery in Dundas, Ontario near the graves of the Pastor and Mrs. Sonnenberg whom she had known in Poland from the time she and Julian became Christians. It was he who officiated at their church marriage ceremony.
